


# Snapshot and Recorder Installation & Navigation Guide



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OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder is OKIOCAM's principal application. This guide will walk you through how to install it on Windows.



In a web browser, go to the OKIOLABS download page (www.okiolabs. com/download/).



Click on **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder** to start the download.




After the download has completed, click on the folder to open it in File Explorer.








Double click on **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder** to launch the installer.






Choose whether to install OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder for all users, or just you.








#### Click **Install** to begin the installation.








Click **Finish** to complete the installation.








Click the **shortcut** on the desktop to launch OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder.






- 1 Press 😂 to show the **Menu**. Press again to hide.

- 3 Press 🔯 to access the **Settings** menu.
- 4 Press to toggle in and out of **Fullscreen**. You can also press Esc to exit **Fullscreen**.
- **5** Press **<** to access the **Settings** menu.
- 6 Press to take a snapshot.
- Press to start recording video. Press to pause the recording.
  Press to stop the recording.
- 8 Press **a** to enter **Review Mode**.








Use the **Zoom** control to adjust the level of zoom. Press the and looks to adjust the level of zoom between 1x and 6x. Zoom can also be adjusted using the slider by left-clicking on and dragging the mouse either up or down.



Use the **Rotate** control to rotate the camera display clockwise and counterclockwise in increments of 90°. rotates the camera display clockwise and rotates counterclockwise.



Use the **Exposure** control to adjust the level of exposure. Press the and icons to adjust the level of exposure between -7 and +7. Exposure can also be adjusted using the slider by left-clicking on and dragging the mouse either up or down.



Press the **Freeze** button to freeze the camera feed.







- If you want to record audio, choose which microphone you want to record from using the **Recording Mic** dropdown menu. If you do not want to record audio, select **None**.
- Set the microphone volume using the slider in the **Mic Volume** section. Drag the icon to raise or lower the recording volume.
- Set the **Display when**recording setting to the on position ( ) if you want to have the ability to adjust the microphone volume directly from within the Live View when recording, and set it to the off position ( ) if you do not.











After the download has completed, click on the **Downloads** folder.








Click on **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder** to start the installation.






Click on OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder and drag and drop it to Applications.








Double click on **Applications**. The Applications folder will open.






Locate OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder in the Applications folder. Right click on **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder** and click on **Open**.








A dialog box will pop up asking you to confirm that you wish to open OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder. Click **Open**.








Click the **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder icon** on the Dock to launch OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder.






- 1 Press 😝 to show the **Menu**. Press again to hide.

Open Google Chrome and go to the OKIOLABS download page (<u>www.okiolabs.com/download/</u>).




Click **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder**. A new tab will open, taking you to the Chrome Web Store.






In the newly opened tab, click **Add to Chrome**.








Once the download has completed, click **Launch app**.








**OKIOCAM Snapshot** and Recorder will open. Click Sign up with Google.






Choose the Google account that you wish to use.








Confirm that you grant OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder access to your Google Drive and Google Classroom by clicking **Allow**.





Click Next.








Choose the location that you want to save your snapshots and videos to. Select Google Drive to save them to your Google Drive. Select On Local Device to save them locally on your Chromebook. It is recommended that you choose Google **Drive**. Once you have chosen, click Next.






Click Finish. OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder is now installed.






- 1 Press 😝 to show the **Menu**. Press again to hide.

- 3 Press it to switch to other OKIOCAM apps. If the other apps aren't open, they will be opened in a new tab. If the other apps aren't installed, you will be redirected to the Chrome Web Store to download and install them.
- 4 Press 🔯 to access the **Settings** menu.
- **5** Press **1** to toggle in and out of **Fullscreen**. You can also press Esc to exit **Fullscreen**.
- 6 Press < to access the **Settings** menu.
- **7** Press 📵 to take a snapshot.
- **8** Press to start recording video. Press to pause the recording. Press to stop the recording.
- 9 Press **I** to enter **Review Mode**.







- 3 Press Google Drive to upload any selected files to your Google Drive.
- 4 Press to open your Google Drive OKIOCAM Files folder in Google Drive.
- **5** Press 🔃 to download any selected files.
- 6 Press to delete any selected files from your computer and Google Drive.
- **7** Press to be presented with the option to delete all files, open a selected file in a new tab, or view information (File Name, Resolution, Create Date, File Size) for a selected file.
- 8 Press lot to toggle in and out of Fullscreen.
- **9** Left-click on a file to select it. Right-click on a selected file to be presented with the options to delete the file, upload to file to Google Drive, open the file in a new tab, or download the file.
